HELPING CHILD CARE PROVIDERS ACCESS ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES

BUFFALO, NY, March 23, 2020— Child Care Resource Network (CCRN) recognizes that in light of the recent COVID-19 outbreak that child care providers are providing our community an essential resource by caring for the children of our essential front-line workers so that they can get to work.

Unfortunately, current economic conditions are stopping providers from accessing the supplies they need to keep their programs running. Child Care Resource Network is doing out part to help Erie County's child care providers by handing out diaper mini-grants. Any child care program that remains open during the COVID-19 outbreak is eligible to receive a grant. Each grant will consist of several packages of diapers and wipes, they will be delivered to child care programs by CCRN staff.

“We are so amazed by the resilience of the child care providers in Western New York. They were called into action at a time when their community desperately needed them, and they came through no questions asked. The least we can do is ease the burden of trying to track down and pay for the essential supplies that they need to keep their programs running.” Says CCRN CEO Kimberly Suminski.
