

# Provider Tip & Activity Sheet

## Bubble Wrap Painting

### INGREDIENTS:

Bubble Wrap

Paint

Construction Paper

Paintbrush

### INSTRUCTIONS:

- Step One- Lay a piece of bubble wrap out in front of each child
- Step Two- Give children an assortment of paint brushes and paint
- Step Three- Let the children paint the bubble wrap
- Step Four- Give the children a piece of construction paper and have them lay it on top of the bubble wrap. Have them gently push it down to transfer the picture onto the paper
- Additional Suggestions- For more control, you can tape the piece of bubble wrap down on the table so it does not move.
- You can also cover the children's hand with bubble wrap, and have them dip it in the paint and paint the paper.
- Target Age Group- All
