Roswell Park Supports Child Care Resource Network at Day of Caring

Buffalo, NY—On Thursday, August 19, volunteers from Roswell Park Cancer Institute will paint a mural on the lobby walls for the Day of Caring powered by United Way of Buffalo and Erie County. The mural, designed by student and local artist Alex LoDico, is inspired by children's author and illustrator Eric Carle and composed of diverse children to reflect the diversity of the region and the families and child care providers whom we serve. The team of ten employees from Roswell Park Cancer Institute was matched with Child Care Resource Network by United Way for the completion of the mural project.

Child Care Resource Network (CCRN) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to child care, early learning, and development. CCRN offers resources and child care referral services to families and employers, child care program registration, training and credentialing for child care providers and the administration the Federal Child and Adult Care Food Program. CCRN also partners with community organizations to provide early childhood developmental screenings and care coordination to children and families in need. The agency mission is to support families, child care providers, employers, and the community by developing and advocating for high quality, accessible and affordable child care and education for all children.
